### **1. Introduction**

I pray for the salvation of the souls of the known and unknown brave martyrs dedicated to the independence, formation and development of the dear motherland Bangladesh, which is glorified by the sacrifice of millions of martyrs.

Sincere gratitude to those who have worked and continue to work selflessly and relentlessly for the continuous work of BCCW. I pray for the salvation of the souls of all those who lost their lives in all the calamities and accidents that happened in the country and outside the country during the year of this work.

With the love and support of all, the current Executive Committee was elected for a 3-year term in accordance with the latest approved constitution at the 31st Biennial Council Session held on March 19, 2021 and assumed office on March 31, 2021. For more than 66 years, BCCW has reached its present position with the concerted efforts of all. In this long cycle the initiative, action and motivation of many are involved; The acknowledgment of their contribution is reflected in every garment of this institution; They are forever remembered by all of us.

Throughout the current working year, the active councilors along with the executive committee members have devoted their valuable time to the service and activities of this institution with sincerity and dedication. Many achievements have been made possible by combining the advice and experience of the seniors with the labor and assistance of the freshers. 7 standing sub-committees and 5 periodic committees were formed soon after taking charge. By implementing their well-thought-out recommendations, the regular programs have been successfully completed on an increased scale, and numerous new activities have been launched this year.

For your information, a brief report of all activities at the end of this working year is presented below:

## 2. Organizational activities

In this working year, 2 general meetings, 15 executive committee meetings, 38 meetings of sub-committees and 36 meetings of various tenure committees have been held.

## 3. Communication and networking with affiliated organizations

English and Bengali New Years, Eid-ul-Fitr and Eid-ul-Azha, Durga Puja, Christmas Day, Great Independence and Victory Day and other festivals including sending greeting cards and letters regularly, exchanging necessary information and communication.

Fruit Festival, National and International Disability Day, World Autism Day, Cerebral Palsy Day, Hemophilia Day, Physiotherapy Day, Mental Health and Health Day and monthly Literary Asar have been conducted regularly with the significant participation of the children receiving services under the programs of BCCW including Children friends of the included organizations. Also, International Mother Language and Martyrs Day, National Children's Day, National Mourning Day, Great Independence and National Day, Great Victory Day, Bengali Year Farewell and New Year, and Children's Rights Week and World Children day, the program has been adopted at a higher rate

Children from various institutions and affiliated organizations, including children of BCCW, have also participated in these events. This time the website of BCCW has been further modernized along with proper use of Facebook and YouTube and individual Facebook Messenger and WhatsApp accounts for Bashikop, Executive Committee, Honorary Councilors have been made more active. Besides, efforts have been made to keep everyone updated on all matters by regularly providing various information through mobile messenger. BCCW cc cameras are active and ensure greater security.

# 4. Regular activities

# 4.1 Feroza Bari Disabled Children Hospital and Rehabilitation Centre

One of the welfare-oriented programs of Bangladesh Council for Child Welfare-BCCW, which started its journey in 1961 as a 'crippled medical center', has promoted the activities of Feroza Bari Disabled Children's Hospital and Rehabilitation Center, which currently has a 70-bed internal department, expanded Medical and Rehabilitation services and has taken extensive initiatives this year through service and awareness training, workshops and meetings-seminars.

Extensive renovations have been done in the hospital this year. Along with this, the Hemophilia Ward on the ground floor of the hospital has been separately renovated and expanded. Treatment rooms and special education program classrooms have been expanded by streamlining reception rooms. Adequate number of disabled children services have been provided in the outpatient department, internal department and extended ward by increasing the required manpower including graduate physiotherapist, speech therapist and occupational therapist. In this year, more than 7000 disabled children and more than 400 disabled adults and needy people have been provided services. With the help of donors and institutions, medical equipment, new beds and side cabinets have been arranged for the hospital.

# 4.2 Adult treatment

Considering the growing demand, Feroza Bari Hospital for Children with Disabilities started from February 2012, along with regular treatment program, supportive treatment program for adults and children from well-off families. Under this, it has been possible to provide more than 3900 physiotherapy services by activating more physiotherapists and Speech therapist this year.

# 4.3 Brace workshop

Brace workshop is a modern program of BCCW since 1988 to prepare and supply orthoses and prostheses i.e. artificial limbs and assistive devices to people with disabilities to overcome disability, achieve independence and assist in normal movement. During this period, 605 supporting materials were prepared and supplied for a total of 520 disabled persons by necessary renovation and expansion of the brace workshop and by increasing the amount of raw materials.

# 4.4 Alhaj Anwar Hossain Disabled Children Education and Development Centre

In 1995 with the financial support of Action Aid Bangladesh and since 2002 on its own initiative to make children with disabilities and their families suitable for education including nutritional and medical care support, special education, and to integrate their families with the mainstream of society, taking the necessary effective measures for the Child Development Project-CDP in this working year.

Alhaj Anwar Hossain Foundation has increased its service space, manpower and scope of work with the financial support of Alhaj Anwar Hossain Foundation from last August 2018 by signing a memorandum of understanding for a period of 2 years in the first phase. At a later stage, a memorandum of understanding was signed with them to extend the funding period of the foundation for another three years. Under this, the project is being run under the name of Alhaj Anwar Hossain Disabled Children Education and Development Center (Bangladesh Council for Child Welfare-BCCW and Alhaj Anwar Hossain Foundation joint project).

Physiotherapy and speech therapy for disabled children, health and nutrition services and school-based special education programs as well as regular sports, dance, music and painting education classes and training programs for disabled children by appointing necessary trainers.

Besides, 142 disabled children, 121 old men and women government allowance and 20 disabled children education stipend has been arranged. A total of about 5000 services have been provided under the project this year. Out of which 1500 physiotherapy, 1050 speech therapy, 1650 occupation therapy, 300 training and 500 education and other support services have been provided.

# 4.5 Training Program

**a.** As part of education and practical training on child development and disabled children and physiotherapy, theoretical and practical training in standard curriculum has been provided to physiotherapists who have completed degree courses of National Orthopedic Hospital and Rehabilitation Institute-NITOR, Institute of Health Technology-Dhaka, Physiotherapy Institute of Medical Technology and Estate College of Health Science affiliated to Dhaka University this year.

Along with that, the students who have passed physiotherapy from National Orthopedic Hospital and Rehabilitation Institute-NITOR, Institute of Health Technology, State College of Health Science and Institute of Medical Technology, Lovely Institute Punjab-India have taken internship for different periods. Certificates have been provided to the participants at the end of all these courses. Various activities including training and services have been conducted jointly with Hemophilia Society of Bangladesh.

**b.** Dhaka University's Department of Social Welfare and Institute of Human Sciences have conducted research and training on disability programs and other activities of the Student at BCCW.

# 4.6 BCCW Special Children's Education School

A special children's education school for disabled and needy children has started its activities by taking a decision at the beginning of this working year. Currently 10 children with one teacher are being provided education services under special management due to inadequacy of space. Plans are being taken to operate it in a more expanded form by consolidating the space in the future.

# 4.7 Monthly Shahitto Ashar

With the aim of encouraging the development of latent talents of children and adolescents in the field of literature and culture, BCCW started a monthly literary event from 8th May 2009. The event is held on the first Friday of every month at 4 pm in the BCCW Auditorium. This year it has successfully completed its 120th edition by regularly organizing Shahitto Ashar in the presence of writing friends. There are plans to release a special issue of Urmi at the end of the 125th season.

# 4.8 Annual banquets and pleasure trips

An annual banquet was organized at Saira Garden, Madanpur, Narayanganj on Saturday, January 14, 2023, for the entertainment of the Honorable Councilors and their family members and the manpower involved in the implementation of the regular activities and programs of BCCW along with their families. Apart from BCCW manpower, honorable councilors, officers and their family members also participated in it.

# International Mother Language and Martyrs Day

**A**. On the occasion of 21st February International Mother Language and Martyrs Day celebration, a group of children from Alhaj Anwar Hossain Handicapped Children Education and Development Center and Feroza Bari Disabled Children Hospital and Rehabilitation Center of BCCW placed wreaths at the altar of Central Shaheed Minar.

**B.** On the occasion of February 21 International Mother Language and Martyrs Day, two weeks long photo exhibition of language movement was organized from February 15 this year with the help of Vasha Andolan Smriti Rakhka Parishad at BCCW premises. Bangladesh Awami League advisory council member and former ambassador Majeda Rafiqun Nessa inaugurated the event. A large number of visitors and children's friends visited this exhibition and gained a proper understanding of the history of the great language movement.

## 4.9 Celebration of National Children's Day and Independence Day

### **Organization of various competitions**

**a**. On the occasion of the National Children's Day on the occasion of the birthday of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, the architect of a thousand-year-old independent Bengal, a human bond was organized with the participation of the needy children and their guardians. On this occasion, various on this occasion, special food was arranged for disabled children and their parents staying in the internal department of Firoza Bari Hospital and Rehabilitation Center for Children with Disabilities.

**b**. On the occasion of Great Independence Day on March 26, a special program was organized for disabled children and their parents staying in the internal department of Feroza Bari Hospital and Rehabilitation Center for Disabled Children. competitions are organized for the children of the included organizations and educational institutions.

**c**. Alhaj Anwar Hossain Handicapped Children's Education and Development Center and Handicapped Primary School students hoisted the national flag, national anthem and flag procession were organized. At the end of the program, a sumptuous lunch was arranged for the hospital residents and sweetmeats were arranged among the school students. BCCW officials were present on the occasion.

**d.** On the occasion of Bangladesh's 52nd Great Independence Day celebration, discussion meeting, prize distribution of Great Independence Day painting competition and cultural programs were organized at BCCW Auditorium on 27th March 2023. Lucky Inam, chairman of Bangladesh Shishu Academy, attended the ceremony as the chief guest and distributed prizes among the awardees. President of BCCW Birmukti joddha Dr. Makhduma Nargis presided over the event.

### 4.10 Apart from this, among all the days Celebrated by BCCW this year, it is notable

English and Bengali New Year programs, Health Day, Education Day, Autism Awareness Day, Hemophilia Day, Physiotherapy Day, National and International Disability Day are organized by the headquarters and Feroza Bari Disabled Children's Hospital and Rehabilitation Center.

**4.11 On the occasion of the 16th World Autism Day on 2 April 2023**, Alhaj Anwar Hossain Disabled Children Education and Development Center organized a human bond with the service recipients and students. Autism awareness campaign was carried out for the common people of the area in human bonds.

**4.12** On the occasion of National Children's Day 2023 Celebration on the birthday of the father of the nation, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, 20 disabled children who participated from NGO World Vision Alhaj Anwar Hossain Handicapped Children's Education and Development Center were presented with various toys.

**4.13 On the occasion of the 65th founding anniversary of Bashikop**, President Bir Muktijoddha Dr. Makhduma Nargis inaugurated a short ceremony by cutting the cake.

**4.14 On the occasion of the 58th birthday of Sheikh Russell**, the youngest son of the Father of the Nation, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, on 18 October 2022, a cake was cut and food was distributed to the children and their guardians at the BCCW Auditorium.

**4.15** Month-long programs are adopted **on the occasion of Children's Rights Week and World Children's Day-2022.** Among the month-long programs, BCCW premises rally and human banding, children painting, music and recitation competitions were organized. The closing ceremony of the month-long program was held on November 8, 2022 at BCCW Auditorium. The Deputy Speaker of Jatiya Sangsad Shamsul Haque Tuku MP attended the event as the chief guest and distributed prizes among the children.

**4.16 On the occasion of the Great Victory Day celebration**, the national flag was hoisted at the BCCW Bhaban and children's flag procession was organized in the Bashikop premises on the morning of 16th December. High quality food was served to the disabled children and their parents staying in the inner section along with the guests and participants.

# 4.17 Disabled child Jannatul Ferdous book cover unveiled.

The book 'Moner Aakash' published with the rhymes and poems of Jannatul Ferdous, written regularly in Bashikop Monthly Literary Ashar, is one of the successes of Bangladesh Shishu Kallyan Parishad. Jannatul Ferdous is a patient in the internal department of Feroza Bari Disabled Children Hospital and Rehabilitation Center run by Bangladesh Council for Child Welfare, Launched on 20 February 2023, a book of poetry titled 'Moner Akash' was launched on 20 February 2023 with raw handwriting as a regular member of BCCW Monthly Shahitto Ashar which started from 8th May 2009.

# 4.18 Educational and recreational tours

According to Concorde Group's approval to provide free entertainment and lunch to 70 disabled children of BCCW twice a year at Fantasy Kingdom and Heritage's Park, on Tuesday 20 December 2022, BCCW organized an educational and entertainment tour to Fantasy Kingdom with 45 disabled children.

# 4.19 Class party and fruits festival

In the month of February, class parties and cultural events were organized with the children of Alhaj Anwar Hossain Disabled Children Education and Development Center. An annual fruit festival is organized in the project office on the occasion of the publication of the half-yearly examination results.

At this time, the results were distributed among the students and the results of the half-yearly examinations were announced. Summer fruits such as Mango, Berry, Banana, litchi, Jackfruit, pineapple, latkon, Guava, Palm etc. were displayed and distributed during the event.

# 4.20 Milad mahfil, Discussion meeting and Iftar mahfil for deceased officials

On Saturday 8th April 2023 at 4 pm in BCCW Auditorium, a discussion meeting and Iftar mahfil was organized on the occasion of Milad Mahfil and holy month of Ramadan in memory of all the officials, councilors, employees including the deceased long-time Vice President M. Azizul Islam.

## 4.21 International Hemophilia Day

On the occasion of International Hemophilia Day, a workshop on Hemophilia awareness and its care and day-long free Hemophilia treatment was organized on Saturday, December 4, 2022 at Feroza Bari Disabled Children Hospital and Rehabilitation Center run by BCCW.

## 4.22 International and National Day of Disability:

On the occasion of 31st International and 24th National Day of Persons with Disabilities on Sunday 5 December 2022, a colorful human chain & rally was organized with the participation of 260 people.

## 4.23 Participation of children with disabilities in winter sports competitions

A two-day winter sports competition for children with disabilities was held at Sultana Kamal Mahila Complex, Dhanmondi, in association with Walton and in media partnership with ATN Bengal, on the initiative of National Forum of Disability (NFOWD). 12 disabled children participated in the competition and won prizes.

### 4.24 Inspection by Bangladesh National Social Welfare Council

A delegation led by Md. Mukhlesur Rahman; Additional Director of Bangladesh National Social Welfare Council visited Bangladesh Child Welfare Council. They expressed their satisfaction by seeing the service activities of the oldest welfare institution.

Later, Professor of Social Welfare and Research Institute of Dhaka University. A team headed by Gholam Rabbani visited BCCW for the purpose of on-site inspection, observation and making recommendations and submitted a post-inspection report to the Bangladesh National Social Welfare Council. In light of that, Bangladesh National Social Welfare Council assured to provide more support to BCCW in future. It should be noted that for this fiscal year, Bangladesh National Social Welfare Council Welfare Council has provided a maximum of Tk 7,00,000/- (Seven Lakhs) as annual grant.

# 4.25 Day long children's book fair

A day-long book fair was organized at Bashikop Auditorium on January 7, 2023 with children's books published by friends and respected councilors of BCCW monthly literary event. The book fair was inaugurated by prominent children's writer Mr. Rafiqur Rashid.

### 5. Self-initiated event

BCCW officers and councilors organized the following programs on their own initiative with the help of interested well-wishers.

**5.1**. Like every time, nutritious food and iftar is organized for the mothers and children staying in the hospital in the holy month of Ramadan.

**5.2**. In the holy month of Ramadan, the first 10 days of Tarabi prayers have been organized at the BCCW office.

**5.3**. Ahona Kabir distributed 50 soft toys to 50 disabled children of Hospital. Engineer Md. Rabiul Alam donated 68,000/- for construction of three patient beds and cabinets for

Hemophilia Ward, Honorable Councilor Mrs. Fauzia Begum Maya donated 13,000/- for quality food, Mr. Abdullah Al Azraf of Dhaka Bangshal 1 wheel chair for disabled children, the students of NITOR provided 3 Therabands and 4 gym balls for the children. Like every month, BCCW executive committee member Meherun Nesa provided powdered milk for children as nutritional support.

**5.4**. On behalf of former President Shah Alamgir's consort and Bashikop Honorable Councilor Fauzia Begum Maya, tables, chairs and toys have been arranged for Bangladesh Shishu Kallyan Parishad Special Children's Education School and patient beds and side cabinets in the interior department of Feroza Bari Disabled Children's Hospital and Rehabilitation Center.

**5.5** Necessary medical equipment was obtained with the help of Sabbar and Sabbir Hossain and a Well-wishers Doctor. Also, through them various nutritious meals are being provided for the children of the internal department.

1,05,000/- medical equipment worth Tk.20,000/- a color printer worth Tk.16,000/- through BCCW Director Easmin Ara Doly. A water purifying fielder worth Tk.16,000/-, 280 kg of rice, 150 kg of potatoes, 600 pieces of eggs, 40 liters of oil, 10 kg of beef, 15 kg of powdered milk, 24 liters of liquid milk, 120 packets of chocolate milk, 40 kg of onions, 20 kg of garlic, 50 pieces of chicken, 20 kg of Chickpea dal, 20 kg lentils, 20 kg khesari dal, 20 kg boot dal, 25 kg dates, 30 kg sugar, 20 kg mudri, 5 kg semolina, 5 kg ginger, 12 packets of Laxus biscuits were found.

**5.6**. In addition, Dr. Makhduma Nargis the president of BCCW, a Goat of Tk 8,000/- through, fruits and jilapi for 15 days iftar through Vice President Nurul Karim Chowdhury Jinnah, 10,700/- by Vice President Dr. Mazharul Mannan and food assistance of 10,000/- through Joint Secretary Nasser Iqbal Jadu; 10 kg powdered milk and 5000/- Zakat received through Executive Committee Member Meherun Nesa.

**5.7**. As financial support, medical equipment worth Tk 50,000/- was received through former president Honorable Councilor Mirjahan Uddin Ahmed Ripon, Zakat of Tk 10,000/- was received through General Secretary Mohammad Monirul Alam. Vice President Haji Altaf Hossain gave 15 sarees and 15 lungis as Eid support. Also, BCCW joint Secretary Dr. Asma Banu donated a microwave to the Al-Haj Anowar Hossain Center for Education and Development of Disabled Children.

**5.8**. Tk.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) was given as donation by Meherun Nesa, Executive Committee Member of the BCCW.

**5.9**. Through the general secretary Dr. Mehdi Hasan and PGCB Chief Engineer Abdur Rashid Khan gave.30,000/- (thirty thousand) as donation.

**5.10**. Children's organizations **Amra Kuri** and **Flowers Bangladesh** distributed Eid gifts to the children in the hospital by holding 2 separate events. On June 16, 2023, a workshop for children with special needs, parents and teachers was organized by Girl Guides Association under the leadership of Executive Committee member Rita Jasmine.

**5.11**. Alhaj Anwar Hossain Foundation on the occasion of Eid-ul-Fitr and Eid-ul-Azha provided Eid goods (Clothes, Saree, Lungi, Salozar-kameez, Punjabi and Frozen Meat, Milk, Sugar, Semai, Polao Rice, Oil, Noodles, Salt, Spices etc.) Project Services Recipients are distributed among children and their families.

**5.12**. Tk.10,00,000/- (Ten Lakhs) Zakat has been received by donors through Treasurer AQM Kibria this year to support the socio-economic development of disabled children and their families. Which is already in the process of distribution.

## 6. Barrister Abdul Gani Khan and BCCW Bhaban construction activities

Bashikop President Bir muktijoddha Dr. Makhduma Nargis 1,42,00,000/- (One Crore Forty-Two Lakhs) by constructing a building in memory of her parents Barrister Abdul Gani Khan and Sekendar Jahan Begum through herself and three other sisters, for the purpose of expanding the disability services and other activities of the Council. Concluded a memorandum of understanding by paying as a grant of taka.

Already the digital survey and soil test of BCCW has been completed and the land clearance of RAJUK has also been completed. Updated land rent paid online. The design of the new building has already been submitted to RAJUK for approval. It is expected that the construction design of the new building from RAJUK will be approved very soon. The Auction process for the sale of the old buildings has already been completed.

# 7. Application for grant from CSR Fund

With the decision of the Executive Committee for the formation of funds for the completion of the construction work of BCCW, applications have been submitted for the purpose of obtaining grants from the CSR funds of the following institutions. a. Bangladesh Bank b. South Bengal Agriculture and Commercial Bank c. Dutch Bangla Bank d. Akiz Group e. Janata Bank f. Lanka Bangla Finance Limited.

### 8. Formulation of employment rules and transmission for approval

A complete set of rules of procedure for the Parishad has been formulated as per the requirements of the registering authority following the relevant clauses of the approved constitution of Bccw. The drafted employment rules have been sent to the registering authority for approval with the approval of the Executive Committee.

### 9. Internal Audit

Initiatives have been taken to properly implement the recommendations of the report of the Internal Audit Committee for 2021-2022 consisting of Honorable Councilors Ruhul Islam Tipu and Deepa Ahmed and Executive Committee Member Prof. Mizanur Rahman Majumdar.

For the fiscal year 2022-2023 an internal audit committee has been formed with Honorable Councilor Ruhul Islam Tipu and Dr Anwaruzzaman Ratan and Executive Committee member Prof. Mizanur Rahman Majumdar.

### 10. Purchase of accounts software to modernize the accounts department

Accounts software has been installed to modernize the accounts department of BCCW in continuation of the formation of Digital Bangladesh. An accountant has been appointed in Accounts Software to speed up the accounts department. At present the operation has been started on an experimental basis. Accounts software will be launched in full soon.

### 11. Liaison, visit and participation with various public and private institutions

1. President Dr. Makhduma Nargis was nominated as a member of the National Child Welfare Board affiliated to the Ministry of Social Welfare and attended two consecutive meetings.

2. Joint Secretary Nasser Iqbal Jadu participated in the workshop on 'Modern Supportive Devices' organized by the National Social Welfare Council affiliated to the Directorate of Social Services.

3. Nasser Iqbal Jadu, Joint Secretary of BCCW, participated in 2 workshops titled 'Progress Review of National Action Plan to Eliminate Child Labour', organized by the Women and Child Labor Branch affiliated to the Ministry of Labor and Employment.

4. BCCW director Easmin Ara Dolly attended the (Comprehensive Care Summit on Hemophilia) Congress organized by WFH and held in Argentina on 8th May 2023.

5. BCCW Director Easmin Ara Doly participated as a Trainer in the training program on "Physiotherapy in Disability and Hemophilia" held at Mirpur CRP organized by Walk for life.

#### 13. Information regarding BCCW funds

Principal and regular source of BCCW Fund is rent for use of building and auditorium and conference rooms; Sale/exchange value of manufactured materials and goods; Various payable service fees etc. Besides, one-time and annual grants from various government and private organizations and individuals and grants from sponsoring individuals and organizations for scheduled events and programs etc. are irregularly added to the Bashikop Fund.

Besides, the income collected and self-financed for the implementation of special programs undertaken by volunteers under this fund is significant. Earlier, on an average, about 75 lakhs to 85 lakhs of programs were implemented every fiscal year. From the last financial year 2018-2019, it has increased to over 1 crore.

Before assuming charge for the current working year, the total fund of BCCW in the month of February 2021 was Tk. 36,974/- (Thirty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Four) was only TK.

For the implementation of various activities and programs in the current working year, the fund status of BCCW at the end of June 2023 is a total of 7,32,51,365/16 (seven crores thirty-two lakh fifty-one thousand three hundred and sixty-five taka and paisa/16) and Alhaj Anwar Hossain disabled children. 5,48,950/- (Five Lakh Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty) Total Fund Status of Education and Development Centre.

5,33, I am thanking Allah for this. Alhamdulillah.98,000/- (Five Crore Thirty-Three Lakh Ninety-Eight Thousand) on 7 FDRs and 1,08,41,224/64 (One Crore Eight Lakh One Forty Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-Four) on 2 FDRs for Development Work and Paisa/64) is reserved TK.

It has been decided to open 3 new (25,00,000/- 20,00,000/- 10,00,000/-) FDRs from the money already kept in the bank.

With your whole hearted cooperation, significant progress has been made in advancing the activities of BCCW towards its desired goals and it has been possible to put the BCCW Fund on a solid footing.

### 13. Future plans

In the coming days, with everyone's sincere cooperation and efforts, for the overall development, structure and development of all the children of the country, it is planned to construct an expanded multi-storied building along with renovation, beautification and reconstruction of the facilities built on the own land of Topkhana Road in Dhaka. Road and land development and boundary wall and beautification plans have also been undertaken. In this regard, the current president of the council 1,42,00,000/- (One Crore Forty-Two Lakhs) received from Dr. Makhduma Nargis on behalf of her along with her sisters will be helpful in implementing the plan. I hope that in the coming days, with the sincere cooperation and efforts of all, it will be possible to get help from more donors and organizations to implement it.
